Accommodation

Urban Camp caters for up to 114 people over three accommodation areas. Our airconditioned, dorm-style accommodation sleeps four to ten people per dorm as well as a wing designed for groups with special needs.

All designated group leader dorms are fitted with innerspring mattresses for your comfort.

All beds are fitted with mattress protectors and pillows. All your group needs to bring is a pillowcase and a sleeping bag.

We understand that some schools have small student numbers. The layout of Urban Camp allows us to accommodate smaller groups, making camps accessible and affordable. Minimum booking fees apply.

Facilities

Our large site offers multiple zones with substantial space to meet the needs of your group. We are surrounded by parklands for sport, games or a general run around.

Safety

Creating safe places for children and young people is at the heart of all we do. The camp is fitted with CCTV cameras with all security access points enabling restricted access to our facility at all times. We only take bookings from school and community groups; no individual or backpacker bookings.

Parking

If arriving and departing by bus, there is a designated bus bay out front and free parking a little further down Bren's Drive for all vehicles. We have trolleys to assist teachers or bus drivers in loading and unloading luggage when the group is not present.





School Bookings

We are a dedicated camp for schools on weekdays during school terms. We understand the role of camp in providing students with opportunities for personal growth and prioritise accessibility for all young people. Our experienced team will help you develop an immersive and educational program.

Catering

Our chefs cook a variety of meals that make you feel like you're eating at home. Served in the warm atmosphere of our spacious dining hall, meals together create fond memories on camp. We offer full-catering and part-catering for our schools: breakfast, morning tea, lunch, dinner and supper. We deliver your lunches to you at your venues in Melbourne. Our friendly catering staff have your needs covered with a plan in place to manage dietary and catering requirements.

Non-School Group Bookings

We provide a city camp base for community groups from country Victoria, interstate, and metropolitan Melbourne. On weekends and school holidays, we take bookings for non-school groups. You can book the site exclusively for your group, all you need is a minimum of 50 people.



Catering

Our convenient location offers easy access to all that Melbourne has to offer. With three tram lines (Trams 57, 58 & 59) and train station (Royal Park station) a short walk away, we can help you book group travel passes for a seamless commuting experience.


Group Travel Pass


Camp Map
